1. Call to Order. COL Nathaniel Carper officially called the meeting to order on September 14, 2023, at 11:00a.m. in JFHQ, TAG's conference room, 4th floor, 47 Bataan Blvd, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

4. Approval of Agenda. COL Carper asked for motion to approve the September 14, 2023, Agenda as written. Mrs. Martinez moved to accept the agenda with one small change, moving the LAB Presentation to C; and the divestments to B; COL (RET) Chacon seconded the motion. All were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion passed and the September 14, 2023, agenda was approved.

5. Approval of the July 27, 2023, Minutes. COL Carper asked for a motion to accept the July 27, 2023, minutes as written. Mrs. Martinez moved to accept the agenda as written COL (RET) Keefner seconded the motion. All were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion passed and the minutes from July 27, 2023, State Amory Board were approved as written.

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6. New Business:

- a. **UNM Taos Renewal of current MOA.** Mr. Louis Moya addressed the State Armory Board. Mr. Moya is requesting approval for the continuation of a MOU that was previously established with the State Armory Board pertaining to the use of the armory located on County Road 110. The lot was used in the past to park vehicles for the commercial truck driving program (Class A and Class B). Currently, the MOU with the State Armory Board is on a month-to-month basis. He is requesting to renew the MOU to continue using the parking lot to store the vehicles.

COL Carper asked for a motion for UNM Taos Renewal of current MOA. Mrs. Martinez moved to accept the motion as written for the approval of the UNM Taos renewal of current MOA. COL (RET) Keefner seconded the motion. All were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion passed.

- b. **Revision of Motions for Divestments of Lordsburg, and Springer Properties as per SBOF Guidelines.**

COL Carper asked for a motion to divest the Lordsburg Readiness Center. CSM Smith made the motion to divest the Lordsburg Readiness Center and donate the property to the County of Hidalgo. The property is in excess and no longer necessary or suitable for military purposes. The donation of this property is subject to approval from the State Board of Finance. The State Armory Board delegates authority to Stephanie LeMaster of the Planning & Programming Department to execute and revise any documents pursuant to State Board of Finance approval and guidelines. Mrs. Martinez seconded the motion. All were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion to divest the Lordsburg Readiness Center passed.

COL Carper asked for a motion to divest the Springer Readiness Center. CSM Smith made the motion to divest the Springer Readiness Center and deed the property to the Town of Springer. The deed restriction is in force being that the property is in excess and no longer necessary or suitable for military purposes. COL Carper moved to accept the motion for approval to divest the Springer Readiness Center. COL (RET) Keefner seconded the motion. All were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion to divest the Springer Readiness Center passed.

9. Issue from the Floor. None


10. Next Meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for December 21, 2023 (1100hrs)
